次の英文を読んで、下記の問いに答えなさい。

(26点)

Have you ever heard of the Titanic? Perhaps you have seen the Hollywood movie that was made about it in 1997. The Titanic was a luxury ocean liner and was launched in 1912. It was designed to carry 2,453 passengers and 874 crew, or a total of 3,327 people. When it was built, it was the largest ship in the world. First-class cabins were like a five-star hotel, and included a gymnasium, a swimming pool, high-class restaurants and cafes, and even a Turkish bath. <sup>(A)</sup>The Titanic was scheduled to leave England every three weeks, sailing to New York and back again.

Before the Titanic sailed, many people thought it would be impossible to sink, or "unsinkable", because of its advanced design. However, just four days after beginning its first trip, the Titanic hit an iceberg<sup>1</sup> in the Atlantic Ocean. The iceberg badly damaged the right side of the Titanic, and it sank two hours and forty minutes later. The wreck<sup>2</sup> of the Titanic now lies almost 4 kilometers deep on the ocean floor.

Over 1,500 people drowned and only about 705 people survived. <sup>(B)</sup>One reason why so many people died was that the ship did not have enough lifeboats<sup>3</sup> for the passengers and crew. Although the Titanic was able to hold up to 64 lifeboats, it only had 20, enough for just 1,178 people. Many people believed that it was unsinkable, so few people worried about the number of lifeboats.

Of the 705 survivors, did you know that there was one Japanese passenger? 【after visiting Russia, for work, and he was traveling back, and England, Masabumi Hosono, his name was, to Japan,】. He was 41 at the time. A local American newspaper wrote about him and called him the "Lucky Japanese Boy".

However, the story of the Titanic is not a lucky one but a sad one. It seems to continue to this day. Just last year, over 110 years after the Titanic sank, five people who went to see the Titanic wreck died in a submarine accident. We should remember that the wreck of the Titanic is a grave<sup>4</sup>, not a museum.
