Imagine you are a tourist visiting Japan. You have enjoyed your stay in Japan. Now it's time to go home. In other words, it's time to find souvenirs. What should you do then?

Try a hundred yen shop! Hundred yen shops offer low prices and a wide variety of products. ^(A) You can get a lot of Japanese souvenirs by spending much less money than you had planned. Hundred yen shops in Japan have become popular among foreign tourists, too.

Why have hundred yen shops been so successful? One reason is the way their goods are produced. These shops have factories located in developing countries like Vietnam and Indonesia. Labor and material costs are much cheaper in these countries than in Japan.

The second reason is the way these shops sell their products. They have developed an efficient franchise system¹. ^(B) Products are brought directly to each franchise shop without going through other companies. The maker sells an item for 40 yen, and the hundred yen shop company sells it for 60 yen to each franchise shop. Then it is sold for 100 yen to customers.

Finally, the idea of one-coin shopping is also appealing. Because hundred yen shops have a wide variety of useful items, shoppers can buy a lot of things for not a lot of money.

Now let's take a look at some typical Japanese goods such as chopsticks, green tea cups, and *maneki-neko* dolls. 【 get, you, you, a, in, are, sushi mold, can, cooking, if, interested, 】. Hundred yen shops are very attractive. Don't you think so?
